Academics

- Average class size of 18 allows for focus on individual student needs
- All-day Kindergarten program sets an outstanding foundation for literacy in a nurturing environment
- Half-day PreSchool programs for 3 & 4 year olds offer a fun, caring environment with a rich variety of learning experiences that encourage each child's development of self-esteem, ability, and intellect
- 97% of 8th Graders were accepted to their preferred Catholic high schools for the past 4 years
- 2006 MEAP Results (Percent of Students that met or exceeded Michigan Standards) :
 - 89% 7th grade Math 94% 7th grade English/Language Arts
 - 96% 8th grade Math 100% 8th grade English/Language Arts 96% 8th grade Science
- Algebra is part of the 8th Grade Math curriculum, fostering success in high school math programs
- Avg. of 150 hours of religious formation per year, including separate weekly liturgies for elementary & middle school classes
- Art, Music, & Physical Education are part of the K-8 curriculum
- Newly updated Computer Lab supports technology skills growth for Kindergarten through 8th grade
- Spanish taught in 1st through 8th grade
- Uniform is white knit shirt & black dress slacks for boys; white knit shirt & traditional plaid jumper, plaid skort or black dress slacks for girls
- Michigan Association of Non-public Schools accredited; teachers certified by Michigan Department of Education
